JAYPEE - UF LINKAGE: B.TECH. 8TH SEMESTER AT UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA, GAINESVILLE, USA

1. Under the MOU entered into between the Jaypee Universities and the University of Florida, Gainesville, USA, select students of **ECE/CSE** from JUET can spend their 8th semester at UF (Department of Computer & Information Science & Engineering-CISE) for undertaking course work leading to the Senior Certificate in Computer Science and Engineering. Credits earned in UL will be mapped to your 8th semester JUET credits.
2. There are several benefits of this certificate programme. Apart from the international exposure, these credits are counted towards your PG credits also (if you plan to pursue MS from UF) & MS-admission criteria is also relaxed for such students. In UF, Prof. Sartaj Sahni (A Stalwart Computer scientist, author of several DS and Algorithms book you study-Horobitz and Sahni), shall remain your contact point.
3. Students have to satisfy eligibility criteria of UF, and will have to undertake 12 credits of course-work (project included). Under the MOU, a special rate of US\$ 460 per credit hour of the course-work as compared to US \$ 1200 per credit hour has been agreed to for Jaypee students (a total of \$ 5520). Besides this, students will have to pay for their accommodation and food for the duration of their stay (16 weeks), which will be on an average US\$ 2500-3000. Students have to make their own arrangements for the purpose of stay, though some guidance may be provided by the University of Florida. It is brought out that approximately 75 to 80 students of Jaypee Institutes are presently located at UF.
4. In case a student wishes to stay on at UF for the MS program in CSE, then he/she will have to satisfy the UF eligibility criteria of GRE score of 305 or better/ TOEFL score of 90 or more as applicable. Please note that participation in the Senior Certificate program does not imply automatic admission to the MS program. Further such student can also transfer upto 12 credits of course-work (graduate level courses) earned at UF from the 8th semester to the MS program in case the students get the grades of B or better.
5. Interested students of 7th semester (odd semester) 2021 **whose CGPA is 6.5 or above**, may submit their CV in the given format available with Mr. Ravi Jha and submit the same to him, **latest by 14th August 2021**, for onward transmission to UF, which shall carry out the short listing based on merit. Students must also note that they will have to make their own arrangements for travel, passport, visa, insurance cover and stay at UF in case selected for the program. Required documents for visa for selected students will be provided by counselor of UF.
6. ECE students may also apply if they have strong programming background (at least 'A' grade in CSE subjects). ECE students will have to do an additional course on Operating System at UF. UF recommends that all selected students complete the course on Operating Systems before joining.
7. In case the pandemic is not resolved in time for students to get visas to arrive at UF in time for Spring Semester, UF plans to offer the Certificate online. In this case, the selection of courses may be less than in the past.
